STEP 1


Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface and turn off the ignition.

**ATTENTION!** The Razor eyes are intended to be used as supplemental lighting only.

Any other use may be in violation of Federal, State or local regulations.

STEP 2

Find a location on the bike to mount the Razor Eyes. You will need a hole at least 3/8" in diameter for the stud (thread is M10 X 1.25) on the Razor eye to fit through. The stud extends 3/4" past the 5/8" diameter flat mounting surface of the Razor Eye. PIC 1

**STEP 3** Insert the stud of the razor Eye through the chosen hole and secure from the back side with the included hex nut and lock washer. **DO NOT** over-tighten the nut on the hollow stud.

Determine if you would like to use the Razor Eyes as supplemental turn signals or running lights.

Turn the key "ON" and using a test light or the wiring diagram for your bike, determine a "keyed" 12 volt power wire (one that has power when the key is on and loses power when the key is off), for wiring as running lights or determine which wires are the turn signal power, left and right, on the bike and a ground wire. Turn the key "OFF", disconnect the battery and attach one of the included Female T-Tap connectors to each of these wires. FIG 1


## ATTENTION! Küryakyn recommends the use of dielectric grease on electrical connections.

STEP 5 Attach one of the included Male Spades to the RED wire from the Razor Eye and plug the RED wire from the Razor Eye to the Female T-Tap on the power or turn signal wire from Step 4. Attach a Male Spade to the BLACK wire from the Razor Eye and plug it into the Female T-tap on the ground wire. FIG 1 Reconnect the battery.

ATTENTION! Secure all wiring away from any moving parts, pinch points or extreme heat. Küryakyn WILL NOT issue a warranty on any electrical component that fails due to pinched, crimped, broken, abraded, melted or frayed wires.

**STEP 6** Secure the wiring out of harms way. Test the lights to make sure they operate correctly.

**WARNING!** ENSURE PROPER LIGHT OPERATION BEFORE RIDING THE MOTORCYCLE. VISIBILITY IS A MAJOR CONCERN FOR MOTORCYCLISTS. A LIGHTING MALFUNCTION COULD RESULT IN DEATH OR SERIOUS INJURY.
